A free display at Liverpool Central Library explores the history, culture, and heritage of British Chinese communities

The Chinese and British Exhibition has been curated by John Campbell and Moira Kenny from the Sound Agents in collaboration with the Liverpool Chinese Community and Liverpool Libraries and Information Services.

Inspired by the Chinese and British Exhibition currently at the British Library until 23rd April 2023, the Liverpool exhibition at draws on personal stories and moments that ask what it means to be Chinese and British.

The display of artefacts track the heritage and history of the Chinese Community and celebrate the lasting impact of Chinese communities across the UK, from wartime service, popular cuisine, literature, sport, music, fashion, and film. The Liverpool Exhibition is accompanied by a printed panel exhibition provided by the British Library, containing complimentary images and information from the London Exhibition.

There will be a series of events streamed UK wide from the British Library, supported by local events in Liverpool to showcase local Chinese culture in the UK, including:

- A Family celebration of the Lunar New Year in Liverpool Central Library on 21st January with British Chinese authors Maisie Chan and Eva Wong Nava 10.30-1.30 pm
- Several events showcasing films, talks and media relevant to the Liverpool Chinese community created, produced, and curated in partnership with The Sound Agents.
- Chinese Storytelling with Movema - Toxteth Library Wed 25th Jan 10am – 12noon and Liverpool Central Library 28th January 10-12pm

The Chinese and British Liverpool exhibition will be available to view in the Hornby Library, 1st floor Liverpool Central Library, William Brown Street. L3 8EW and will be available for public viewing during library opening hours from 16th January 2023 until 31st March 2023.
